

MULTIPURPOSE BUILDING

The current 20 residents at the ranch are in need of more classroom, chapel, and dining space. We cannot bring in more boys until this project is finished. Currently the slab, walls and steel trusses are complete. It will take approximately \$70,000 to finish this building.

SPONSORSHIP

Heart of the Bride has lost some sponsorship for the monthly budget at NBR, but has given permission for us to offer individual sponsorship to each of the residents that have shown the commitment to stay in our program for at least 1 year. We are really excited about this opportunity as we see how it can be both enriching for the sponsors and the boys themselves. If you would like to commit to sponsor a Nehemiah boy on a monthly basis, it will cost about \$100. Although this amount does not cover all the expenses it takes to staff and run the Ranch, it will be a huge help in providing clothing, food, housing and education to each boy. VEHICLE

When we first arrived in Zambia, we purchased a 10 passenger van that we knew would eventually be used full time at the Ranch. We have now graduated to that level and have surrendered that vehicle full time to the Ranch. We are currently in need of a vehicle that can hold our family when we return to Zambia. The cost of a used, reliable van will be between \$15-\$20,000.

SCHOOL TEACHER

It is time again to recruit for a full time teacher for the Walker children. We have 7 eager students. Candace would be able to train someone if God is doing the 'calling'. A 2 year commitment is required.

BOARDING SCHOOL TUITION

Next year, Shad (16) will be attending a missionary kid's boarding school, Rift Valley Academy, in Kenya for his 10th and 11th grade year. The approximate cost with airfare will be about \$6500. We are trusting that God will make provision for this need as we move forward in faith.
